1. REGISTRATION

Great Room in the Base Camp, Sunday 6pm-9pm; Monday 7:30am-12 noon and 5pm-7pm

Come to registration on Sunday Night to pick up your lanyard and lift tickets.

MEALS ON YOUR OWN

Lunches are up to the individual.

There's no group dinner on Tuesday night. We suggest you book well in advance for the Lodge's main restaurant, Alpine Hall. Otherwise there are a number of great restaurants 15-25 minutes away from the Resort in Stowe, some of whom have donated **gift certificates** that will be raffled off at Monday's dinner event.

No group meals (or events) on Wednesday.

4. ACTIVITIES ON THE SLOPES

Lift Tickets

If you signed up to ski/snowboard, you'll receive a 2-day lift ticket at Registration. If you wish to ski a 3rd day, we can provide you with a voucher that entitles you to purchase an additional day at a discounted rate. If you know in advance you would like to ski an additional day, we can email the voucher to you before your arrival. All additional tickets can be purchased directly and in person at the ticket office in the Base Camp. Vouchers can be emailed in advance for your convenience, but we will also have the information at registration as well. If you plan to arrive in Stowe early and wish to purchase a discounted ticket for Sunday, we will need to know in advance so we can email the voucher you will need to present at the ticket window before your arrival.

If you have an Epic pass, please be sure to bring it to Stowe with you!

Kids Adventure

Act fast if you plan to register your child for ski school! If you wish to sign up for **Kids Adventure (ski/snowboard lessons for various levels)**, parents/guardians should register online through www.stowe.com (see the "DISCOVER SKI SCHOOL / Lessons" section). Reservations will need to be made by calling Stowe directly at (802) 253-3685.

- Please register **well in advance** as enrollment is limited and typically sells out. **DO NOT WAIT TO ARRIVE IN STOWE TO MAKE YOUR ARRANGEMENTS.**
- Guests are responsible for purchasing all Adventure Center lessons directly through Stowe. Once you sign your child/children up for a program, the Adventure Center will give you instructions on how to proceed and where to go the day of your lesson. There will not be a representative from the Adventure Center at the FCS Registration, which is another important reason to book early and guarantee your spot for lessons.

RENTALS

If you're looking to rent any equipment, stop by **Pinnacle Ski & Sports** (1652 Mountain Road, Stowe) before you get to the Lodge. Mention FCS Race for Kids and **get 20% off!**

5. ACTIVITIES OFF THE SLOPES

Cross-Country Skiing

The [Cross-Country Center](#) is just 10 minutes from the Lodge. You can rent equipment and pay for a permit for their trails.

Snowshoeing

You can also snowshoe at the [Cross-Country Center](#). Or rent shoes at the Lodge and **hike on your own for free on the Resort property** (e.g., across the golf course or up Mountain Round towards Smugglers Notch). You can also pay for a guided tour (with hot cocoa!). **Reservations can be made through the Lodge by calling 802.760.4061. We recommend you do so in advance!**

Ice Skating

The outdoor skating rink is open and free. Skates are available to rent. Hours are Sunday 12:00pm-6:00pm; Monday & Tuesday 12:00pm-9:00pm (weather dependent).

Sledding

There's a **great hill for sledding/tubing** behind the Stowe Elementary School (254 Park St.). Bring your own or buy plastic sleds at Shaw's General Store on Main Street.

Fitness Center

Hours of Operation: 5:00am - 10:00pm

Plenty of **workout equipment** is available for free in the fitness center overlooking the outdoor pool.

Outdoor Pool

The pool is heated and there are **two outdoor hot tubs.**

Spa

Hours of Operation: Spa/Salon 8:00am - 7:00pm Daily

Reservations are strongly recommended as there is limited staff available. Call 802.760.4782.

Kids Camp

The FCS partners with Apple Tree Learning Centers to provide two **FREE** fun and stimulating evenings of Kids Camp on January 9 & 10 for children 5-12 years old. This year camp will run from **7:00 to 10:00pm** on both Monday and Tuesday nights. Campers will have opportunities to participate in a themed activity each night, as well as enjoy a variety of fun games and crafts. **Sign up for free at Registration Sunday night.**

Babysitting

You must book in advance! Call Apple Tree Learning Centers 802-253-4321. Note: Apple Tree runs our on-premises Kids Camps, and recruits babysitters on a demand basis.

- The price per baby-sitter will be \$30.00 – \$35.00 per hour depending on the number of children.
