

Dear Outing Guest,

The Wykagyl Management has been working hard to create a safe and enjoyable experience for all Outing guests. Please, **if you are feeling ill with fever, cough or shortness of breath, we ask that you not attend the outing.** Below we have outlined the many safety actions that have been taken to ensure your safety at our beautiful Club:

Food & Beverage Safety Actions

- Daily temperature readings are being taken and logged for all employees.
- Staff that has travelled internationally or to US "hot spots" will have to wait 2 weeks to return to work.
- All clubhouse employees are required to wear a face mask that properly covers their nose and mouth. Food & Beverage employees will change gloves at least every 30 minutes or immediately if soiled.
- Wykagyl Country Club is required to provide its employees with all necessary personal protection equipment mentioned above.
- Outdoor dining tables have been appropriately spaced 6 feet apart.
- Inside seating capacity is limited to 50% with 6 feet of separation space per table.
- Grill room, Locker room, pro shop, main dining room and administrative offices HVAC units have been upgraded with **bi-polar ionization devices** to purify the supply air killing bacteria, viruses and mold.
- The Clubhouse water system was tested for Legionnaires disease before re-open. It can develop after prolonged closure.
- Hand sanitizer stations are located in every area of the Club.
- The Club has upgraded to a hospital grade cleaner that is EPA compliant to kill COVID-19.
- The frequency of daily cleaning of dining areas, locker rooms and restrooms has been increased.
- Sharing of Staff Equipment has been drastically limited.
- We have instituted an extensive employee training program that strictly follows **CDC, New York State and Westchester County Health Department Regulations.** Training includes:
 - Protocols on how to clean and use cleaning products (including disinfectants) safely
 - Cleaning checklists and appointed employees responsible for each task

- Daily staff refreshers on our safety regulations
- Clear signage in support of our new policies has been posted in Member and employee areas.
- Social distancing protocols are enforced.
- Mandate that employees must stay home if sick/experiencing symptoms

Caddie & Golf Cart Safety Actions

- Daily temperature readings are being taken and logged for all caddies and cart staff.
- Caddies that have travelled internationally or to US “hot spots” will have to wait 2 weeks to return to work.
- Hand sanitizer is readily available for caddies.
- Caddies wear masks at all times during the rounds they work and while on Club grounds. However, there will be times when caddies are out working on the golf course and are able to maintain significant social distancing from golfers and other caddies. At these times, caddies may remove their masks from their faces, but they must be replaced when social distancing is no longer possible.
- When transferring a club to and from a player, the caddie will hand and receive the club by holding the club head end of the club. This transfer should take place with both the caddy and the player having arms outstretched in order to maintain social distancing. And in this way, caddies will only handle club heads and will not touch grips. Players only handle grips, and do not touch club heads.
- Caddies will not handle a golfer’s golf ball.
- There are partitions in each golf cart to allow participants to share a golf cart and social distance.
- Every effort will be made by golfers, caddies, professionals, starters and other golf staff to maintain proper social distancing at all times.
- Golf Carts are cleaned and disinfected with bleach after each use.

Golf Course Safety Actions

- There are no bunker rakes on the golf course.
- EZ-lift devices are installed in the cups so the flag stick is not touched.
